BUOY FIELD RULES AND REGULATIONS

Tahoe Yacht Harbor, L.L.C, dba Tahoe City Marina, hereafter known as "TYH", adopts the following rules and regulations regarding the use and access to the Tahoe City Marina and buoy field.

1. **Signs:** Boat owner or boat owner's representative, hereafter known as "Owner", and owner's guests shall not be allowed to place any signs including, without limitation, signs that read "for sale", "for rent", or "for charter." All such signs and/or information relative to owner's desire to sell, rent or charter their boat may be left in the marina office for distribution or viewing by prospective customers.
2. **Living on Boat:** No boat shall be used as a living quarter without prior written authorization from TYH.
3. **Hazardous Substances, Fueling and/or Repair Work:** No sewage is to be pumped or otherwise deposited in the lake at any time. Boats shall not be fueled when on buoy. No gas cans are allowed in the harbor area beyond the marina gates. There shall be no repairs or any work on a boat on a buoy which could cause pollution of the lake or interfere with the quiet enjoyment of the harbor. If any boat requires repairs which are not otherwise prohibited, any repair man must have written authorization from the owner and shall be presented to the marina manager prior to any repairs taking place. TYH reserves the right to refuse access to the marina and/or to authorize repairs if it appears, to its discretion, that such repairs could cause pollution and/or interfere with the quiet enjoyment of the harbor.
4. **Articles Left:** TYH assumes no responsibility for any articles of personal property, or otherwise, left on the pier or catwalk.
5. **Tie Downs:** All boats shall be secured to the buoy using no less than a three-fourths inch (¾") line with at least three-fourths (¾) ton attaching hardware spliced to the line using thimbles. The total length of the buoy line shall be no less than fifteen feet (15') and no more than eighteen feet (18') for vessels up to twenty-seven feet (27'). For vessels longer than twenty-seven feet (27'), the total length of the buoy line shall be no more than twenty-one feet (21') no less than fifteen feet (15'). Boats shall not be tied up to any of the perimeter piers surrounding the marina. Any boat found tied up to a perimeter pier will subject the owner to prosecution and removal of the boat at owner's expense.
6. **Quiet Enjoyment:** Owner and owner's guests shall not engage in any activities which interfere with the quiet enjoyment of others using the buoys, pier, marina and/or harbor.
7. **Unauthorized Use:** There shall be no commercial operations in the harbor without obtaining the prior written consent of TYH. Unauthorized boats found on a buoy, in the pier, marina or harbor will be removed at owner's expense. No one under the age of 18 will be allowed access to the marina unless accompanied by an adult. When accompanied by an adult, children shall be monitored by the adult at all times while on the piers or in the harbor area. There shall be no diving or jumping off any piers. Children shall not be allowed to play on or around the launching equipment. There shall be no jet skis or waverunners allowed in the marina. There shall be no cleaning of fish in the marina.
8. **Parking:** There is no public parking or vehicle access from the mall entrance to the lake shore during the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
9. **Damage to Boats or Personal Property:** Should any incident arise which results in damage to a boat or personal property of another, owner or owner's guest shall report the incident and the damage immediately to the marina manager and/or TYH.
10. **Revocation of Use:** Any use of the buoys granted by TYH is permissive and is revocable by TYH at its discretion. Any violation of the rules by owner or owner's guest may result in the loss of rights to use a mooring space at the marina and/or to use the harbor in general.
11. **Access to Mooring Space:** Owner's guest must identify themselves to the marina manager prior to being allowed access to a buoy. There is a shuttle service provided to and from buoy's during the seasonal term of May 01 to September 30. Weather permitting, buoy shuttle service hours of operation during the months of May, June, and September are 8:00 am to 5:00 pm Monday thru Friday, and 7:30 am to 6:00 pm Saturdays and Sundays. During the months of July and August, the shuttle service will run seven (7) days a week from 7:30 am to 9:00 pm. A dingy boat will be provided for those who wish to come and go before or after hours.
